This statement sets out Blythe Bridge High School & Sixth Forms arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at our school to share information about other F.E Providers Education or training offers.

This complies with the legal obligation under section 42B of the Education Act 1997 and the 'Baker Clause'.

As part of our schools Pathways and enrichment programmes, we use The Gatsby Benchmark as a guide.

Students in years 8 - 11 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships through option evenings, assemblies and group discussions and taster events
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses
