- Report regularly on students' progress both in and out of the classroom
- Expect high standards, set clear rules, promote mutual respect and tolerance and develop a sense of responsibility
- Treat everyone fairly and with respect
- Keep you informed of concerns or incidences of misbehaviour and eventual consequences
- Keep parents informed about school matters, be welcoming to enquiries and responsive to concerns
- Reward effort, progress and achievements on a regular basis
- Offer extracurricular activities to support their personal development and wellbeing

As a parent/carer I/we will:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time
- Contact the school with an explanation on the first day of any absence and then keep the school informed on a daily basis
- · Ensure that no time is taken out of school unnecessarily
- Inform the school of any changes of circumstances that might affect my child's learning, health or behaviour
- Encourage my child to work hard and support them with equipment and homework by checking the ePlanner regularly
- Check my child's use of social media and seek advice if and when appropriate
- Support the school in ensuring that my child behaves in an appropriate manner on the way to and from school
- Support the school's policies on behaviour, uniform and safety
- Attend progress evenings and meetings about my child's progress and behaviour
- Encourage my child to participate in the extracurricular opportunities to support their personal development and wellbeing
- Ensure my ParentPay account is regularly topped up and all required payments for made in advance
- Keep the school informed of any changes to contact details.
