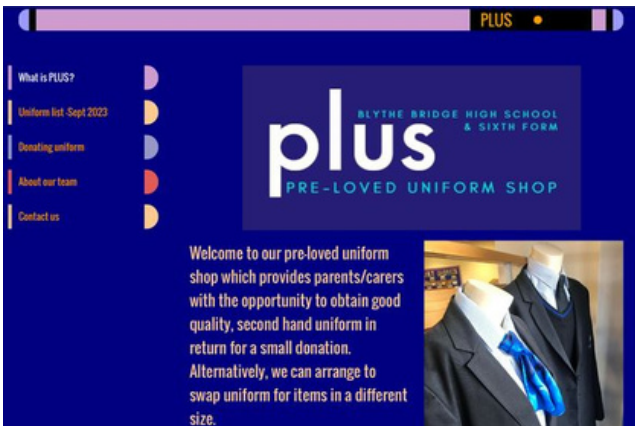
We are always keen to connect with our former students; their experiences are invaluable to our careers provision in school.

## PRE LOVED UNIFORM



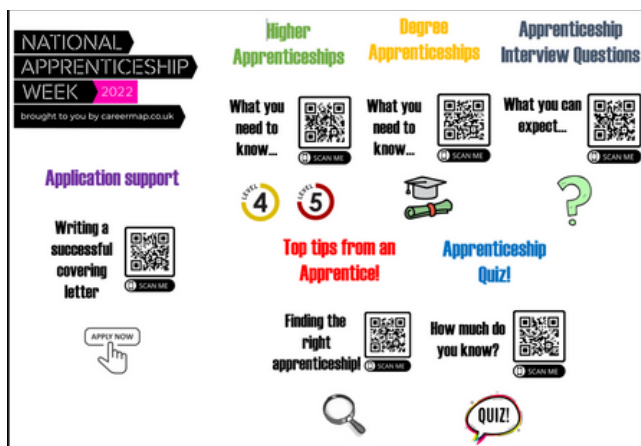
