BRILLIANT CLUB

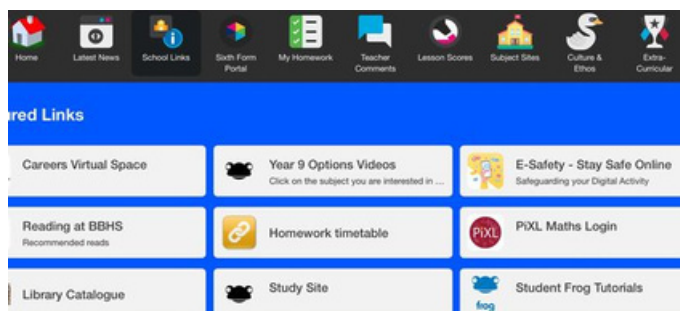
