We look forward to seeing your designs and hope you join us in supporting equality, diversity and inclusion.

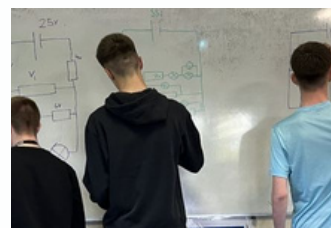
