Next week, the temperature continues to fall and there is rain forecast. We will continue to make blazers optional but students should wear ties and scarves as usual from Monday.

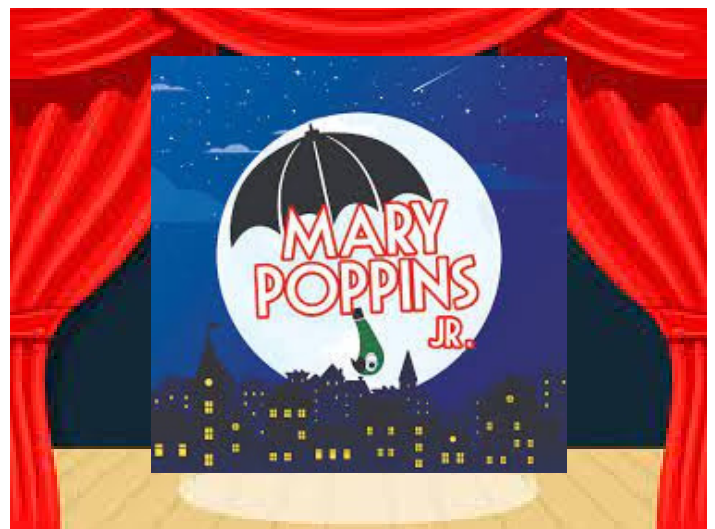
Hopefully the weather will be settled, and not too hot, for all the transition events and activities we have planned across the rest of the term.

THREE PLAYER CHESS



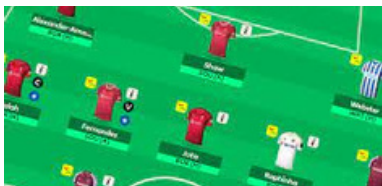
Last week the BBHS chess league had its first ever three player chess match! Well done to Dexter H who was victorious in a closely fought match against Michael F and Thomas M.
