

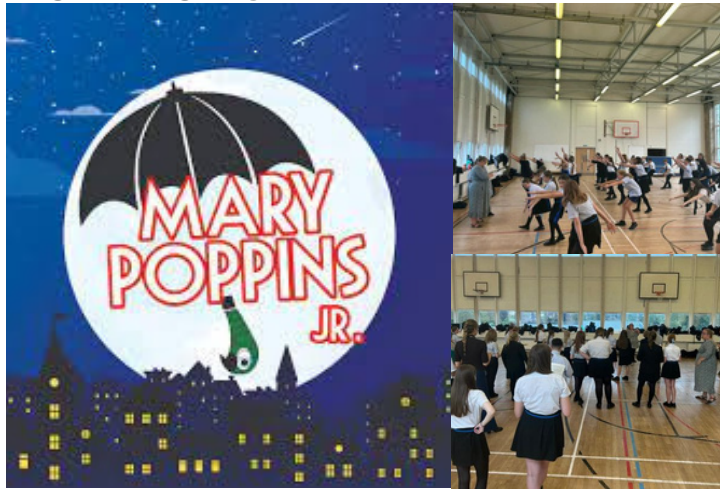

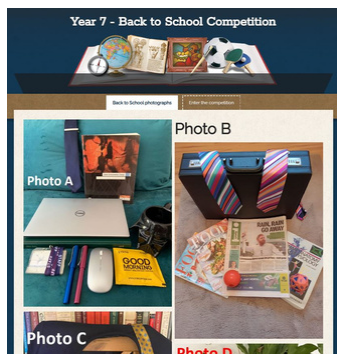
## LIFEGUARD OPPORTUNITIES

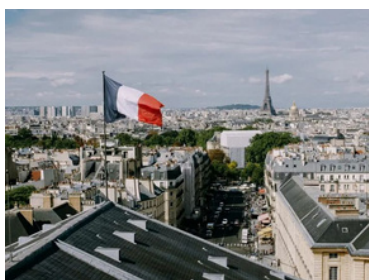
## YEAR 7 COMPETITION

our students can experience the French culture and heritage for themselves. Just watch this space!

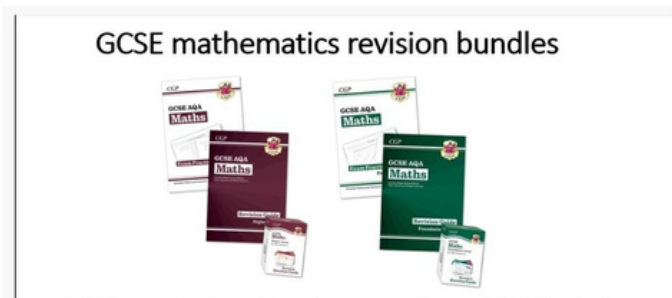
## ALUMNI PORT VALE DEBUT

## REVISION BUNDLES



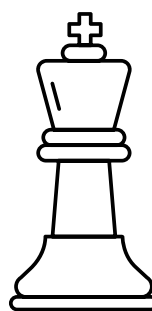
