Special thanks go to our guides, who showed families around their school with such enthusiasm, and all the students who volunteered to help in departments. Let's not forget all our valued staff.



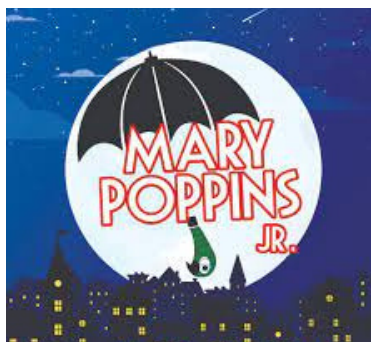
MARY POPPINS

A reminder to bring in some change and book a ticket for this mini afternoon tea event as tickets are limited.

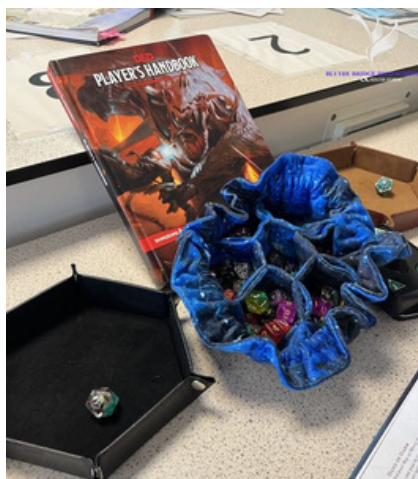
LIBRARY AMBASSADORS
