GIRLS' FOOTBALL

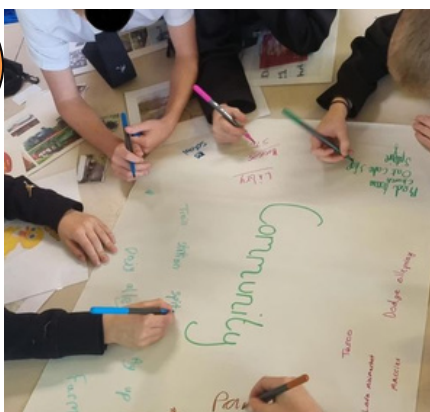

Can you help our school become more green? Our PRK team have already had a positive impact on the environment with the introduction of the daily recycling of plastic bottles but they would now like to eliminate

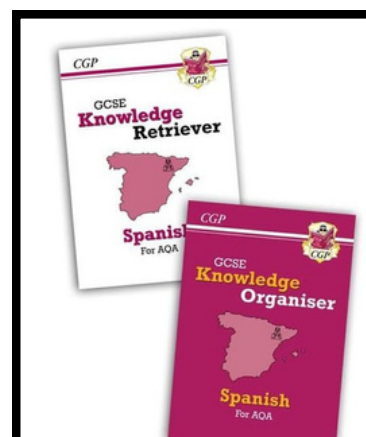


the use of single use cups used for hot drinks at events such as concerts and parents' evenings.
