



Cashless Catering

Blythe Bridge High School & Sixth Form offers a biometric cashless catering system. The biometric system supports the improvement of our school meal services and provides us with a more efficient, faster and ultimately better quality of service.

The system incorporates the latest technology and eliminates a need for students to carry cash throughout the day. A session will take place within the first two weeks of the Autumn Term where your child will have their thumb print taken, in the meantime your child can still purchase food by giving their name to the catering team, once the biometric is complete, the meals taken will be deducted from your ParentPay account.

Any amount of money can be paid into a student's account and any money spent on food & drink will be deducted on a daily basis. Parents/carers will be able to see cash available via ParentPay.

As per current legislation, we will be operating an 'opt in' policy and therefore we will require you to complete an authorisation form, which is below for your completion.
