The online shop will be open from Monday 8th April 2024 and will close on Friday 3rd May 2024. After this deadline, NO ORDERS will be able to be placed.

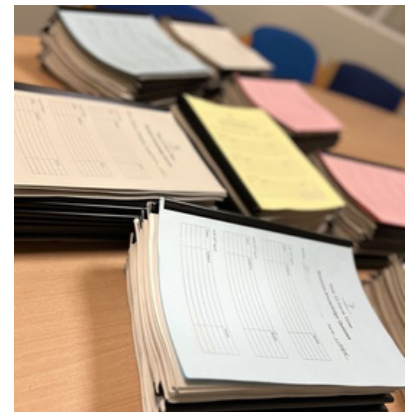

We have extended the deadline for ordering parent packs to Wednesday 24th April. All of the packs already ordered have been sent home with your son/daughter.



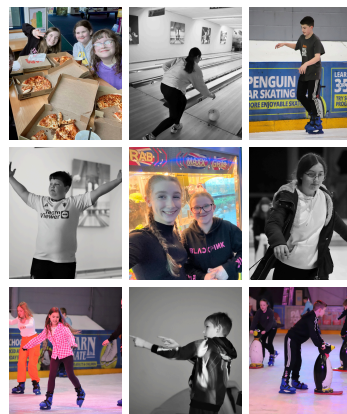
SCIENCE CHALLENGE

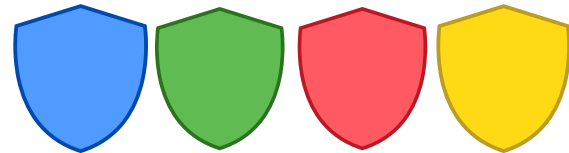
