My role involves supporting children, young people and their families with mental health difficulties using Low Intensity Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (LICBT) interventions. Through our collaboration, we can work together to identify and address difficult emotions and feelings.

I work in partnership with the school Mental Health Lead to deliver whole school approaches such as workshops, groups and training to improve outcomes for pupils and their families.
