We celebrated another set of excellent results as students received their GCSE and BTEC grades. The school was particularly proud of great individual some achievements such as Will's 7x9s and 2x8s

and our dual linguists, Sam, Charlie, Hannah and Evie who achieved 9s and 8s in French and Spanish. We are also proud of how many students have made amazing progress during their time at the school through their dedication and that of their teachers.

As а result, many headline measures were the best achieved by the school, with an incredible 72% of students achieving a grade 9-4 in both English and maths, with half of students achieving a strong pass (grades 9-5) in both of these subjects.

We celebrated the achievements of а remarkable group of Year 13 students when they received a set of excellent results in their A level and BTEC courses. Students have gained places to study further at a variety of universities and across a whole range of
