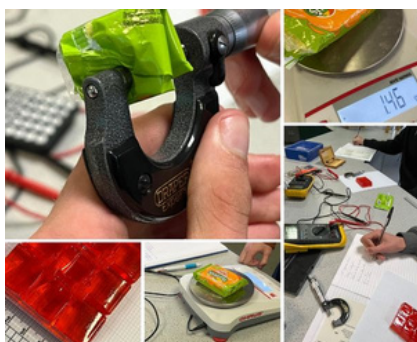


### PREFECT TEAM

## ROCKIN THE AUDITIONS

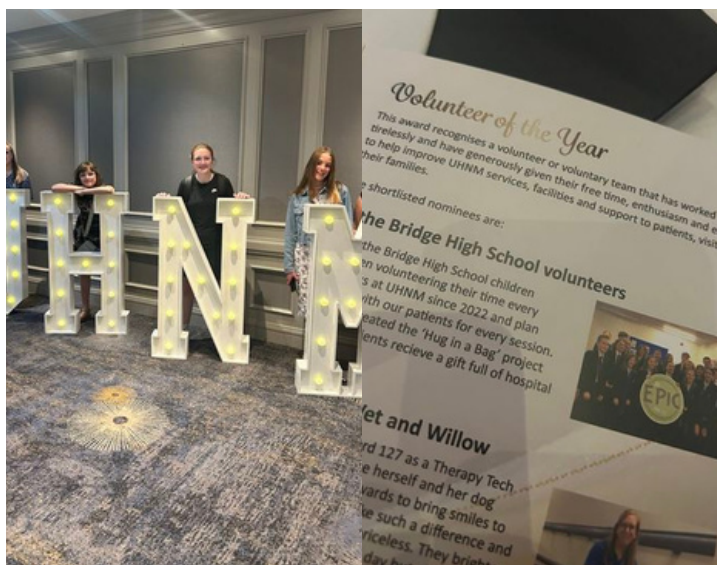


It was wonderful to have over 70 students from across all year groups auditioning for "We Will Rock You" after school last week. The sounds of Hammer To Fall rebounded around the

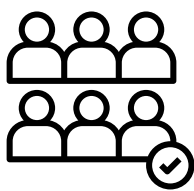
